

Applicant Timeline for Students

January of 3rd year

- Confirm with EM advising that EM is among your top career choices
- Check in with EM advising about 4th year schedule
- Plan to do EM at UW/HMC early (by July), then away in July-Sept
- Start early research into programs using EMRA match and SAEM catalog

February

- EM Faculty Career Advisor (FCA) assigned
- Start looking into away programs for an away elective
- Meet with FCA, talk about away planning
- “EM Away Rotations” advising session/recording

March/April

- “How to succeed in your EM clerkship” meeting/recording
- Start applying for away rotations

May/June

- Confirm away rotation
- Continue research into programs for application

July

- Check in with FCA to debrief after clerkship and plan application
- Personal statement workshop/recording
- Update your CV
- Send your personal statement to your FCA by 7/31

August

- Review your initial program list with your FCA
- All LORs should be requested (unless still rotating or soon to be)
- Consideration of a parallel plan if needed

September

- Submit your ERAS application in a timely fashion
- SLOE from UW will be uploaded for you
- Plan for interviews—UWSOM practice interviews helpful

October-December

- Touch base with FCA about interviews received
- Touch base with FCA as needed during interviews

February

- Work with advisor as necessary to set rankings

March
