Online Renewal Process:

1. Select “Renew Application Online” (Shown above with red arrow)
2. Click to “Begin Application Process”—You will need to log in using your name, as it would appear on your DEA license.
3. If used on previous applications, you will need to enter your SSN and Tax ID Number:
UWMC Tax ID Number: 91-6001537
HMC Tax ID Number: 91-1631806
4. Once the initial information is filled out, the exemption screen will open and **request the following information:**
 - a. **Name of Fee Exempt Institution:** enter your primary place of practice: **UWMC or HMC**
